Re: Cancer Climb & Trek for Prostate Awareness at Gran Paradiso Massif, Graian Alps, Italy, September 10 - 18, 2016

Dear Friend of the PAF,

I hope this letter finds you well. I would like to talk to you about what has become the most controversial subject in men's health - prostate issues. Lately, not only have the treatment options for prostate cancer come into question because of the high rate of recurrence, but even whether or not to undergo a PSA (a blood test to uncover prostate cancer) at all is being debated.

PAF has planned a special climbing and trekking expedition to the Graian Alps. The objective: to summit Gran Paradiso, the highest mountain in Italy at 13,324' / 4,061 M. This will be the 16<sup>th</sup> annual *Cancer Climb and Trek for Prostate Awareness*. This mountain climb is designed to raise awareness and funds for PAF's **Sustainable Prostate Project**, and outreach and support services for men & their families who are dealing with prostate cancer or other prostate-related health concerns.

This climb will raise critically needed funds to allow the PAF to continue its mission and services.

- This year over 200,000 men will be told they have prostate cancer. 1 in 5 men diagnosed is under 60 years old!
- There is no one conventional treatment option superior to another. The recurrence rate after treatment is over 40%. Men need to remain vigilant after treatment, but in many cases they do not.
- The side effects of conventional treatment are in many cases more damaging than the disease itself. Incontinence, sexual dysfunction and emotional trauma are common.
- Making a treatment path decision can be overwhelming. How do you separate "marketing hype" from reality?
- Only 3 % of those diagnosed will die from the disease, and the latest clinical research on prostate cancer indicates that many men are being over-treated for a disease that is unlikely to kill them.
- There is a time and a place when aggressive intervention is necessary. But often times it is not.

Men need to have a better understanding of their treatment options and their side effects. They need to learn how to take better care of their prostate before they have problems. Won't you please make a donation in support of the expedition to help the PAF continue its critically important outreach and education programs?
