Take Hwy #101 to San Marin Drive in north Novato and head west 2.7 miles. San Marin Dr. turns into Sutro Ave at Novato Blvd. Follow Sutro Ave one mile and turn right at Vineyard Rd and follow 1 mile. The trailhead is on the left where the paved road becomes a dirt road. The trail ascends uphill about 1,000' and is in shade a good part of the way.

Wear layered clothing; bring plenty of water and a snack. Hiking poles are always helpful. Yu don't have to have a prostate to participate.
