Pyrenees Mountains, September 12 - 19, 2020

- ◆ This year about 200,000 men will be told they have prostate cancer
- ◆ Every 90 seconds another man is diagnosed with the disease
- ◆ 30,000 men will die from prostate cancer this year
- ◆ One of five men diagnosed will be under 60 years of age
- ◆ 30% of all US men have undiagnosed prostate cancer by age 60
- ◆ In many cases men are being over-treated for a disease which will not progress

Since 2001, a select group of prostate cancer veterans, their family members, loved ones and friends have been participating in the annual Cancer Climb & Trek for Prostate Awareness expedition. The 2020 expedition will climb and trek in the Pyrenees Mountains of Northern Catalonia (Spain, France, Andorra). Summit attempts of Mt Aneto and or Mt Canigou will be a challenging test. A support team will also participate.

For all the expedition members, this is an opportunity to focus national attention on the prostate cancer epidemic while sending a message of hope and inspiration to those afflicted with the disease. Daily activities are designed to help men take a proactive approach to prostate health with an emphasis on diet, stress reduction and healthy life style. We would like to ask you for your support and help in achieving our objectives.
