Jan was an extraordinary man- a PAF mentor, registered nurse, men's health instructor at San Francisco City College, and a dedicated family man. He helped countless men deal with their prostate health issues. An avid hiker and outdoorsman, Jan loved California and its outdoor opportunities.
