Spring Camping and Hiking Getaway At Pinnacles National Park Sunday, April 24 – Thursday, April 28, 2022

DETAILS FOR PARTICIPANTS

Where: Pinnacles National Park, 32 miles south of Hollister, CA off Hwy # 146. Our campsites are in Loop G, Site #'s 117 & 118

When: Sunday, April 24th, check in time is 1pm. Leaving Thursday morning, April 28th @ 11am

Who: Due to Covid concerns the maximum number of participants will be limited to 14 (7 per site). Participants will be required to present a vaccination record or a negative Covid test that taken no more than 72 hours before arrival. You don't have to have prostate issues to participate and women are most welcome.

What: Gourmet car camping at its best. All meals are included in your \$100 per night fee. Breakfast and dinners will be prepared by PAF staff. Supplies for make your own lunches will be provided. Meals will be prostate friendly and in just about all cases organic. Snacks and alcoholic beverages are your responsibility. Hiking trails vary from easy to challenging. Day time temperatures can reach 80+, last year at this time they never went over 75. Night time temperatures never went below the mid-40's. Rain is possible, but unlikely. There is a camp store, hot showers and a swimming pool are available.

Gear: The PAF has all the necessary items for meal prep, eating and cleanup. We have a small van rented for most all the gear. If you have room for some of the team equipment that would be great.
