Santa Rosa, CA: Want to get away? The Prostate Awareness Foundation once again is sponsoring a Spring Prostate Gathering at Pinnacles National Park in Central California. The dates are Sunday, April 24 to Thursday, April 28, 2022. The PAF went there last Spring and had a memorable experience. This unique area on the San Andreas Fault, south of Hollister and east of the Monterey Peninsula is truly spectacular. The area is noted for its unusual rock formations, caves and condors.

This is gourmet car camping at its best. This national park features a camp store and hot showers are available for a fee. Trails vary from easy to challenging. The PAF has reserved two large group camp sites for the 4 nights. Due to continued Covid concerns the group will be limited to a total of 14 participants, seven per group site. We ask that everyone be vaccinated or present a negative Covid test that was taken within 72 hours of arrival.

The cost is \$100 per night and includes the campsite rental and all prostate friendly breakfasts, lunches and dinners. Snacks and alcoholic beverages are not included. All you need is a backpack, sleeping bag, air mattress and tent. The PAF has a limited amount of loaner tents, just let us know if you need to borrow one. We encourage you to come for the full 4 nights stay, but consideration will be given to those interested in a shorter stay. Come join us and other health conscious individuals for a memorable experience in the wild. \$100 deposit reserves your stay. A fundraising flier will be available for those wanting to defray the cost of the trip.
