

Our home base is Guerneville Lodge located on the Russian River with beautiful grounds and within easy walking distance to downtown. The lodge is a rustic gem built in the 1930's with twelve rooms all with private bathrooms. We will cook prostate-friendly food together, go on hikes and do a special tour of The Cedars of Cazadero, relax in a healing guided meditation, sing dance and enjoy music by the Prosta-tones and John E. Crash, play in a drum circle, and have a lot of fun stargazing with Dr. Jack Bacon at the New Moon Star Party!

Friday, April 17th: 2 hiking options, Easy or Aggressive

11:00am – Option #1 Aggressive: Meet and park in the parking lot at **Armstrong Redwoods State Natural Reserve** just outside the entrance on the right at 11am. We will hike the forest floor, then up into the hills for up to a 2,000' elevation gain. 3-4 hours. Bring your lunch, hiking poles, water and a snack.

1:00pm – Option #2 Easy: Meet at Armstrong Redwoods State Natural Reserve in Guerneville at 1pm and hike the forest floor. About 2 hours with no elevation gain.

3:00pm – Check in to Guerneville Lodge, 15905 River Road, Guerneville, CA 95446

5:00pm – Hors d'oeuvres & oysters on the half shell shucked with love by The MotherShucker with n/a beverages and red wine from Wild Hog Vineyard and wonderful whites from Woodenhead Winery.

6:00pm – Dinner, Vegan or Pescatarian with live music by the Prosta-tones.

New Moon Star Party with Dr Jack Bacon

The new moon on Friday April 17 affords an opportunity for optimal stargazing. We will peer into the heavens in search of...

Saturday, April 18th:

7 to 8:00am – Very early breakfast and then make your own lunch for the day before we head to Cazadero for a 3-4 hour hike and a low impact tour of The Cedars, an ecological preserve. It is a moderate hike with some elevation. *"Concealed deep within the heart of Sonoma County, out of sight and hard to find, is The Cedars — a mysterious, unearthly region still known to only a few. Located north of Cazadero at the headwaters of Austin Creek, access to The Cedars requires seven creek crossings in a high clearance vehicle. But with risk comes reward and this journey brings the sojourner to an unexpected new world — a world of deep serpentine canyons, strange, mineralized formations, Mars-like terrain, and rare & unusual plants."* There is a 20-person maximum for this hike, first come - first served.
