Big Rock Ridge Trail, Novato-San Rafael, Marin County
Monday, February 23, 2026, 10am
Moderate to Strenuous
4 hours, 1400' elevation gain, 7.5 miles

The summit is the 2nd highest in Marin County and offers 360-degree views of the bay area and beyond. This is an out and back hike so you can shorten this hike to 3 miles by turning around from above the Skywalker Ranch.

Hwy # 101 to Lucas Valley Rd, Exit # 456, then follow Lucas Valley Rd West for about 5.5 miles to the Big Rock at the crest and park on the side of the road. The trailhead is on the north side of the road.

Wear layered clothing; bring plenty of water and a snack. Hiking poles come in handy on this one. Trail talk tends to involve prostate issues. Women are welcome to join the fun.
