



10th Annual Bill Kortum Memorial Hike on the Sonoma Coast

Kortum Trail, Shell Beach, Sonoma County

3 hours, 100' elevation gain, 3 miles round trip

Bill Kortum was one of Sonoma County's pioneer environmental activists. He was instrumental in stopping the nuclear power plant planned for Bodega Head. He also helped create the California Coastal Commission which set limits on development along the entire California Coast. Bill passed away in 2014 after a long battle with prostate cancer.

Meet at the parking lot at Shell Beach – parking is free. To reach the shell beach parking lot drive along Hwy #1 about 7 miles north from the town of Bodega Bay. The parking lot is on the ocean side of Hwy # 1.

Wear layered clothing; bring water, trail snacks and your lunch. If weather permits, we will have lunch at Blind Beach before returning to the trailhead.
