



23rd CANCER CLIMB & TREK FOR PROSTATE AWARENESS San Juan Mountains of Southwestern Colorado September 12-19th, 2026

- ◆ This year about 200,000 men will be told they have prostate cancer
- ◆ Every 90 seconds another man is diagnosed with the disease
- ◆ 30,000 men will die from prostate cancer this year
- ◆ One of five men diagnosed will be under 60 years of age
- ◆ 30% of all US men have undiagnosed prostate cancer by age 60
- ◆ In many cases men are being over-treated for a disease which will not progress

Since 2001, a select group of prostate cancer veterans, their family members, loved ones and friends have participated in the annual Cancer Climb & Trek for Prostate Awareness. The 2026 expedition will take place at the San Juan Mountains in the Colorado Rockies. One of the highlights will be a visit to Mesa Verde followed by a summit of Engineer Peak, a climb that offers varying levels of difficulty - allowing more of our climbers and support team members to participate.

For the expedition members, this is an opportunity to focus national attention on the prostate cancer epidemic while sending a message of hope and inspiration to those afflicted with the disease. Daily activities are designed to help men take a proactive approach to prostate health with an emphasis on diet, stress reduction and healthy life style. We would like to ask you for your support and help in achieving our objectives.

- Generate critically needed funding for prostate education, awareness and prevention programs.
- Inspire men and their families with the knowledge that there can be a rich and rewarding life after diagnosis.
- Take a pro-active approach to prostate health
